Closing Date: Entries will be accepted until 6:00 PM on Thursday, Feb 16, 2012 after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

Entry Fee: \$50.00. A \$0.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee is included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per CH 11, Sec. 2 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. Make checks payable to SDTC (Sacramento Dog Training Club)

Tracking Test Entries: Dogs holding the title of Tracking Dog shall not be barred from competition; however, dogs not having a TD will be given preference by the Test Secretary. Entries are limited to 12 dogs. **Certification Letters and checks will be returned for dogs not passing or not drawn into test AFTER the test date!**

The Draw: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing time and date to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Thursday, Feb 16, 2012 at 6:15 PM, 6030 Jeremy Ct., Carmichael, CA 95608

Alternate List: An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries which are to run.

Notification: Notification of the draw results will be made BY EMAIL and snail mail, as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Test Secretary.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Refund policy: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

Bitches in season may participate: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the test, notify the test secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the test site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the test secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the test site and any award withheld.

Draw for running order: All entrants must be at the test site by 7:00 AM the morning of the test, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

Judging will begin as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged.

Awards: A dark green qualifying rosette will be awarded to each passing dog along with a frame and calligraphy map of the passing track.. A photo of each passing dog will be taken and emailed to the exhibitor.

Dogs on leash: "All dogs and bitches entered in this test must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards. This also applies to any non-entered dogs that may accompany anyone at this test."

Directions to test site: **From Sacramento** take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Sunrise Blvd. South exit and go 4 miles to Douglas Rd. Turn right on Douglas Rd. and go 1 mile to Eagles Nest Rd. Turn left on Eagles Nest Rd. Go 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. **From Placerville** take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento and follow the above directions.

Practicing is allowed in the fields. The areas we are allowed to use are anything on the right after you turn onto Eagles Nest all the way to Woodring Rd. and anything on the left past the golf course. Please do not use the area on the right beyond Woodring as dogs are no longer allowed in that area.
